The meeting was called to order by Chairman Joan Marshman at 7:00. The clerk read the minutes of the last meeting which were approved as read. The treasurer gave the treasurer's report which was approved and is as follows.

Heritage Preservation Committee-We discussed the Villa Angela property and Vallahala Park. The Township cannot vacate the property and it is now up the courts to decide.

Old Business-The Villa Angela has to go through the vacation of part of Lake Avenue again because the DNR was not notified the first time. There was a motion made and second to set a hearing date for April 27th at 7:30 at the Town Hall. The motion passed.

Harry Roberts from the Frontenac State park came and gave the annual report for the State park and gave the Township a copy of the new Frontenac State Park management plan. We have put thirty acres on the east side of the park and thirty acres on the west side of the park into potential buying sites at a future date. We have removed the lots along Westervelt Avenue from the park boundaries. We have acquired one hundred and five acres from the Villa Maria.

New Business-The Township Annual election is Tuesday March 10th. The polls will be open from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with the annual meeting to follow.

We have received the new fire and ambulance contracts. The fire contract is \$39,344.82 with two payments one on March 1st and the second one on September 1st. The ambulance contract is \$10,445.03 with two payments one on March 1st and the second one on September 1st. A motion was made and second to accept the fire and ambulance contracts for 2009 with Lake City. The motion passed.

We received a letter from Amtrak regarding the recent accident at the crossing on Ski road and Hill Avenue. A motion was made and second to sign the acknowledgement letter to Amtrak. The motion passed.

We will advertise for sealed road maintenance bids, rock bids and mowing bids to be opened at the March 23rd meeting at 7:15.
