Meeting Minutes, March 20, 2012

Meeting Called to order at 7:00 pm

Minutes of February meeting were approved.

One DRA was considered regarding a request from Wayne and Sue Wandmacher, at 29330 Van Blarcum Avenue, Frontenac, to erect a pre-built, 10 x 12 foot, temporary shed on their property to serve as a studio and playhouse. The DRA was approved. Discussion then ensued regarding whether the Residents' Resource Guide should be updated to contain clearer guidelines regarding temporary structures. The HPC will continue this discussion at our next meeting.

The Lilac Give-Away will be held on Saturday April 14th in Wakandiota Park from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Art will coordinate the event with Joyce Smaby. Volunteers are welcome.

Friends of the Town Hall reported that they have been awarded an \$8,000 annual budget this year and next for maintenance of the Town Hall. They reported that the community vote at the Annual Meeting was unanimously in favor of maintaining the Town Hall. Judy Johnson, of the Friends of the Town Hall, will work with Kerby Rigelman both to review the current maintenance priorities the Friends recently developed, and create construction specifications to address these priorities. Art Hamilton will coordinate the next steps in this process with the Town Board.

HPC members again encouraged the Friends to serve on the HPC and apply to the Town Board at the upcoming Township Meeting.
