

## Historical Preservation Commission

Meeting Minutes, June 19, 2012

Meeting Called to order at 7:00 pm

There were no minutes from the May 15th, 2012 meeting to approve.

We discussed eventually revising the Residents' Resource Guide for Old Frontenac. The HPC will begin this process when its new Ordinances are approved in July, 2012.

The HPC's new ordinances which include language about the new Town Hall being an Historic District and no longer having jurisdiction over the parks of Old Frontenac will be approved at the July town board meeting.

The meeting of the new Park Commission's June meeting was reviewed. Brad Stone reported that the listening session with township residents went well. The tone of the meeting was positive, and many issues concerning the parks were discussed including, playground equipment in three of the parks, the tired condition of the outhouses and the pavilion in Wakandiota, and the general health and Wooded Overlook possibilities in Valhalla.

Brad Stone provided an update for Christ Church. He reported that the stained glass windows are now in Winona being restored and the siding replacement should begin later this summer.

The Town Hall becoming an historic district was discussed and will be presented at a public meeting to be held before the July town board meeting and to the town board for its approval at the June meeting. The documents will then be submitted to the county and state for their consideration.

The HPC will begin the process of looking for a grant writer to assist with the process of applying for grant money to restore the Town Hall.

The HPC will request to hold Preservation Day with the Friends of the Town Hall in their fall event.

The HPC will develop a policy for temporary structures as the Residents' Resource Guide is developed.

The Town Board will announce at its next meeting that the HPC needs two new members.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm
