

Florence Township Long-Range Planning Commission

Minutes – 6/11/07

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jan Bruce at 7:10 pm. Members present were Jan Bruce, Ben Boege, Joe Ellingson, Rick Janka, Eric Stensrud, and Brian Schreiber. Members not present were Kristen Eide-Tollefson, Lowell Noreen and Vern Genzlinger. A quorum was present. Clay Ruggles, representing the Township Board was also in attendance.

Minutes of the 5/14/07 meeting were not reviewed and will be at the 7/9/07 meeting.

Unfinished Business: This meeting was intended to inform residents of Frontenac Station about the Hwy 61 changes that are being considered. Representatives of MNDot were not able to attend and do not have a plan in place to discuss so were not present to review how the changes will affect Frontenac Station or the residents that have property adjacent to Hwy 61.

Jan did outline some of the comments that were shared with the Planning Commission from MNDot at a previous meeting. A copy of that report will be filed with the monthly minutes of the Planning Commission.

Some questions have been raised regarding the building permit of James Kranz, Section 26 and the proposal he presented to the Twp Planning Commission at the April 10, 2006 meeting. At that time he requested a variance for the site of the location of the house he was planning to build. County records do not indicate he actually requested or was issued a variance. Ben agreed to check with Bob Johnson as it was assumed Bob did attend the County Planning Commission meeting that this would have been discussed.

New Business: No new business or issues were brought before the Commission.

With no other business items to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned.
