Florence Township Regular Monthly Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00. The clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. There was a motion made and second to approve as read. The Motion passed. The treasurer's report is as follows: A beginning checking and money market balance of \$ 438,506.31, receipts of \$44,258.37, disbursements of \$ 21,323.58 for a total checking and money market balance of \$461,441.10. We have one CD for \$87,896.79 for a total cash and investments of \$549,337.89. There was a motion made and second to approve as presented. The motion passed.

Zoning-Resolution pertaining to building permits was amended from old resolution. The fee for solar gardens was changed. Motion made and second to pass the resolution. Motion passed.

30684 County 2 Blvd Michael Carson build an out building. They have planning commission approval. Motion made and second to approve as presented. The motion passed.

Gordy Simonson-Solar Stone we have received County approval the conditions set forth by the town board were discussed and agreed to the requests of the town board 1 1/2 thick over lay on County 2 Blvd from County Road 2 to the Frontenac pit, \$100,000 road bond, collect and remove debris . There is a motion made and second to approve the conditional use permit for Solar Stone. With the request letter as an addendum. The motion passed.

Evan Carlson - 1 mega watt solar garden. We have planning commission approval if we put screening along county road 2. Motion made and second to approve. The motion passed.

Josh Rolbiecki build a garage 31990 territorial Road 28x32 . They have planning commission approval. Motion made and second to approve as presented. Motion passed.

Planning Commission-We had the three permits that were just approved. We discussed the ski jump and if there would be erosion issues with the ski jump.

Heritage Preservation commission- We need members

Parks-We are hoping to have the debris at the end of the beach removed by the contractor that volunteered to do so. We are looking at new decking material for the boat ramp dock. A new dock would cost about \$2000.00. We will see if the sportsman club would be interested in donating. New windows in community center have been done. The dump needs to be burned. A motion made and second to have road contractors burn the dump. Motion passed. We have a resolution to accept a donation of \$500 from Ron and Peggy Knudsen to be used for the dock . Motion made and second to accept the resolution. Motion passed.

Peggy Knudsen has joined parks commission. Motion made and second to accept Peggy Knudsen to the park board.

Friends of the Town Hall we are looking at having a history fair April 22nd. We have a request from the Goodhue County Historical society for a donation.

Old business- Letter from Mary Boom lives on Westervelt Avenue requests that the Township not use magnesium chloride but rather calcium chloride for dust control also that she has a three day advance notice before application, request that the minimum amount of de-icer be used between the two state park signs. We have made a motion and second that we received the letter and will respond accordingly. Motion passed.

New Business-A letter concerning and active 4H group in Florence Township. Joe responded to the request.

Goodhue County Historical Society request for donation. A motion made and second to donate \$500.00. Motion passed.

Goodhue county partnership for seal coating. There was a motion made and second to partner with Goodhue County for seal coating. The motion passed.

Contact State of MN about light bulbs in the street lights.

Tom Johnson is concerned with the condition of locust lodge and The possible danger of fire risk to his property.

All outstanding bills were paid.
