

Florence Township Heritage Preservation Commission

Meeting Minutes from 12 June 2018

Three members, Bill Bruce, Bill Flies and Cathy Kouchich and the Town Board representative, Jan Bruce were present.

The meeting started at 6 PM.

Bill Bruce stated that no response to the letter to Margaret Anteblian had been received. The next step is uncertain.

Bill Bruce reported that a bid was solicited from local professional painter, Jake Davidson. Bill met with Davidson at the Town Hall to evaluate the work, consisting of painting the remaining exterior wood features of the building, consisting of the soffit, the fascia the window trim and the stairs. No bid had been received by the time of the HPC meeting.

Bill Flies presented a document titled "Frontenac Point Heritage Preservation Plan". It described the chronological history of the changes to the geography of Frontenac Point from the late 1800s to the present day. It proposes a plan for the future use of Florence Township park shore land from Block 9 (the former Villa Angela site) to Block 13 (roughly, the site of the bridge on Lake Avenue north of the Chateau Frontenac). The plan attempts to balance public use of the shore land while respecting the Chateau Frontenac home owners.

Bill Bruce proposed that the HPC members examine the plan over the next month and discuss it at the next HPC meeting. All members agreed.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45 PM.
